Open Public Meeting Act: The notice requirements provided for in the Open Public Meetings Act have been satisfied. Notice of this meeting was properly given in the Annual Notice of Meetings which was adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners, March 7, 2007. Said resolution was transmitted to the Asbury Park Press, filed with the District Clerk and posted in the Cliffwood Fire House.

After the reading of the Open Public Meeting Act, the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, Township of Aberdeen was called to order on Monday, August 6, 2018 at 8:00PM in the Cliffwood Fire House.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of July 2, 2018 were passed out to all Commissioners and the public. Additions, corrections and/ or deletions will be addressed at the end of the meeting.

<u>Building and Grounds</u> – Comm. Bellamy states, air unit and fan is not working in executive office. Will get pricing. A new system was estimated to be ~\$4,500. Comm. Connelly makes a motion to get a new system, not to exceed \$5,000. Comm. DeGiglio seconds it.

<u>Truck, Radios and Equipment-</u> Comm. DeGiglio reports, 491 has been worked on. Waiting on hydrant sys value plant. Trip sheets are needed from the officers. Equipment is ordered. Need to order 3 gas meters at \$749 each which will come with training. Comm. Connelly makes a motion, Comm. Bellamy seconds it. Conical's will be placed on trucks before Clean Air comes in Sept. Will need to receive 2 prior.

<u>Old Business</u> – No report

<u>New Business</u> – Comm. Black reads Resolution 2018-8 (please see attached). Lettering will need to be removed from Dodge Durango before title is transferred to Commercial truck. Pierce provided paper work to Enter a contract for purchasing vehicles. Comm. Connelly makes a motion, Comm. DeGiglio seconds it.Resolution to be made. All in favor.

<u>Insurance</u> – Comm. Black reports, Mike Downey is now insured. There's a need to have periodic insurance updates.

Chief's Report – There were 25 Calls for the month of July and 81.20 man hrs.

<u>Bureau of Fire Prevention</u> - Comm. Marsh reads report. \$3,535 was deposited in the Boards account. Fire Official states, there are a few fire works this month. All is well. The Chief would like to lead a Motor Cycle parade.

<u>Training grounds</u> – Comm. Bellamy reports, Needs to call another fence company. No one was getting back to him.

<u>Public</u> – Comm. Connelly makes a motion to except the previous months meeting minutes. Comm. DiGiglio seconds it. All were in favor.
